To create an education movement that transforms the lives of marginalized children by imparting quality education and STEM learning; and empower the youth with employable skills and community by accessing their rights and entitlements.

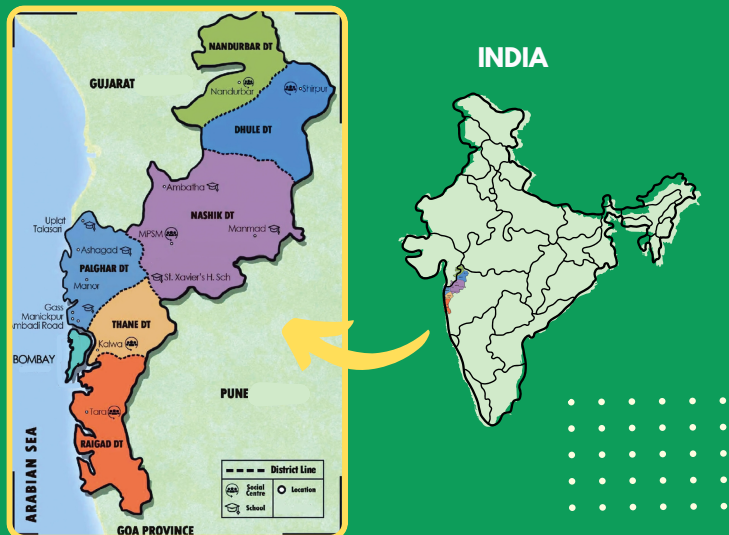
The Learning Crisis in India:

Despite the Right to Education Act, millions of children in India lack foundational literacy and numeracy skills. According to the ASER 2024 report, only **23.4% of Std III students** in government schools can read at a Std II level. Post-pandemic school closures further worsened the crisis, with many children losing years of progress.

- **Over 70% of children in slums lack grade-appropriate learning skills**, making it difficult for them to progress in school and acquire life skills.
- **High dropout rates among marginalized children**, especially girls, due to socio-economic barriers and lack of access to quality education.

REAP is addressing this urgent issue by providing targeted education programs that equip children with essential skills to succeed in life.

Foundational Learning

Bridging literacy and numeracy gaps for children in Classes 1-8, ensuring they gain essential skills to progress in education. This program includes remedial coaching and structured learning support to help students reach grade-level competencies.



Early Childhood Education (ECE)

Preparing young children for school through our Little Angel's English Nursery, focusing on cognitive and social development. Our ECE program fosters curiosity and early learning through play-based education, ensuring children develop school readiness.



Computer & English Training

Providing computer training and language skills, equipping children with tools to navigate a technology-driven world.



STEM Education

Introducing children to Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics through hands-on learning, critical thinking, and innovation.



We have partnered with institutions to set up STEM Learning & Research Centres, equipping children with 21st-century skills.
